#### SAFETY PRESENTATION: In-Touch Fleet Management

1. Services: Teen Driver Monitoring and Commercial Fleet Management
2. Fleet Management Service
  - a. Live vehicle monitoring via GPS units in tractor cabs
  - b. Monitors route progress (moving, stopped, etc.)
  - c. Also monitors speeding, idling, excessive acceleration and braking, refrigerated trailer temperature monitoring, engine condition (i.e. oil pressure, engine temp., etc.) and RFID monitoring (to include two-way communication between dispatch and the driver)
  - d. Allows user to set goals for any of the monitored data
  - e. Customizable reports and dashboards produced by In-Touch (included in cost of subscription)
  - f. In-Touch does not currently offer in-cab video monitoring at this time
