The U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) is responsible for enforcing federal laws that make it illegal to discriminate against a job applicant or an employee because of the person's race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, disability or genetic information. It is also illegal to discriminate against a person because the person complained about discrimination, filed a charge of discrimination, or participated in an employment discrimination investigation or lawsuit. Most employers with at least 15 employees are covered by EEOC laws and the laws apply to all types of work situations, including hiring, firing, promotions, harassment, training, wages, and benefits.

EEOC representative, Elaine MacArthur, will give an overview of the laws enforced by EEOC, recent litigation, and the agency's focus under their new Strategic Enforcement Plan. Safety and Health professionals are responsible to ensure that these laws are not violated.
