Presenter: Mark Seig, Clinical Director of Goodwill Industries – Suncoast Inc.

The presentation described Goodwill Industries 6-month residential drug treatment program. This program is a non-voluntary program from convicted felonies that are court-ordered to go through the 6-month program. Goodwill Industries maintains a 41-bed residential treatment facility at their St. Petersburg location. The program uses a therapeutic community (TC) approach whereby the residents work together in a team atmosphere using peer-pressure but in addition, each resident is assigned a primary counselor. This is a very comprehensive and rigorous program which includes a 3-month commitment following the 6-month stay. The after program includes required group therapy and drug testing.
