- Use Credit Cards instead of Debit cards for maximum protection and less liability
- Always select the DEBIT function never the CREDIT function on your ATM card
- Cancel existing Debit Cards and request a new one from your bank to start all over
- Place either a "Fraud Alert"(good) or a "Credit Freeze"(best) on your 3 Credit Reports
- Shred all store receipts that have an imprinted bar code
- Never give out personal information over the phone until you have verified the caller
- Restaurant servers can easily skim your Debit/Credit cards, pay your bill with cash
- Protect RFID credit/debit cards, Driver's Lic.& passports with a "Data Blocker" card in your wallet
- Use PayPal or a reloadable debit/gift card for all your online purchases
- Use your Bank's online "FREE" Bill Pay System for paying all your bills

))) **\*\*\*IDENTITY THEFT ALERT:** The new bank cards with the chip are always transmitting Debit and/or Credit Card information that can be stolen by hackers up to 30 feet away!!!\*\*\* A "Bank Card Data Blocker" will prevent the transmission of the vital credit and debit card information in any wallet.
